Birds in emergency placement can be placed and then moved immediately to a foster home or out for adoption if the Adopt-A-Bird Committee sees fit and it can take up to 30 days to resolve a foster home or adoption, so Emergency Placement can be for as long as thirty days. A home inspection by a committee member is required.
